This 1.5 day seminar is designed to introduce practitioners to the techniques of Dry Needling using acupuncture needles in the treatment of myofascial trigger points. These techniques offer a safe and effective way to rapidly deactivate points using sub-dermal and intra-muscular needling techniques. The course is highly practical and delegates are normally confident to needle their patients after the seminar.

John Reynolds qualified in medicine in 1975 and subsequently pursued a specialist career in rheumatology and rehabilitation medicine in the RAF. He was Chief Medical Officer for the British Paralympic Team for eight years. Dr Reynolds has been a practising acupuncturist for twenty years. He is a past Chairman of the British Medical Acupuncture Society (BMAS) and remains a regular lecturer on BMAS Introductory and Post-Basic courses. His acupuncture training and practice is Western orientated although he does embrace some traditional meridian theory.

Sharon Reynolds qualified in physiotherapy in 1990. She became interested in dry needling/acupuncture when injured, and received treatment, at the 1992 Barcelona Paralympics. After completing the introductory course in 1994, she has gained experience in both the NHS and private practice. She has been assisting Dr John Reynolds in teaching the practical aspects of the course since 1996, teaching across the three main therapies.
