He has BHS qualifications in horse knowledge and riding and has competed in Hunter Trials and Team Chasing, which has given him a better understanding of the performance of horse, saddle and rider. Laurence is a Fellow, former President and current member of the executive committee of the SMS, which is dedicated to improving the saddlery trade, helping to develop saddlery and saddle fitting. He is the current chairman of the south west region of the Worshipful Company of Saddlers and, in 2005, was granted the Freedom of the City of London in acknowledgement of his services to the trade.

Sonya qualified as a Chartered Physiotherapist in 1985, initially working in a wide variety of settings in the human field. Her veterinary physiotherapy experience dates back to 1987 when she became one of the first 20 members of ACPAT. Since then she has had extensive experience as both a clinician and clinical educator.
